How will I know if ODOT plans to acquire my property or part of my property?

Right now, no residential or business relocations are anticipated. Some temporary rightof-way and sidewalk easements will be needed in places. If you are affected, an ODOT representative will reach out to you. The process started in 2025.

What if ODOT needs temporary access for construction or maintenance?

ODOT may need to temporarily use property during construction. You will still own the property. If this affects you, a representative from ODOT will contact you. The process started in 2025.

When will construction start?

Construction is set to begin in 2028. The date relies on federal funding and could change.

How will the project be built?

The project will be built in phases to maintain access to US-75. During construction, a minimum of one lane of traffic will be open in each direction. Access to residences and businesses will be reduced and delays should be expected.

How will the project affect my commute?

Due to the size of this project, travelers should anticipate delays, longer drive times, and congestion. US-75 will stay open throughout construction with at least one lane in each direction. Access to homes and businesses on US-75 will always be available. We will do our best to keep congestion and delays to a minimum.

Will I still be able to get to my home, business, or property during construction?

Yes, you'll still be able to get to your property. Sometimes, temporary drives might be needed until they are fixed. Gravel may be used for temporary driveways during construction.

What happens to my driveway or entrance?

ODOT may rebuild or repave them up to the existing or temporary right-of-way line. Some may be realigned to be at right angles to the highway.

What happens next? What is the project schedule?

You can share your thoughts on the project until December 29, 2025. ODOT will start buying land and moving utilities in 2026. Construction is scheduled to start in 2028.
