108. Director's Report – Information Only

Director Tim Gatz provided an overview of the County Road and Bridges (CIRB) program and expressed appreciation for the Commission's approval of it's 5-year plan update. He explained that the CIRB program allows county commissioners to pursue large-scale infrastructure projects that would otherwise be financially unattainable without dedicated funding. The CIRB work plan, which paralleled the Department's 8-Year Construction Work Plan, is reviewed and rebalanced annually. Gatz highlighted the continued challenge of cost escalations experienced over the past four to five years, though he noted a decrease from the peak increases of 18% annually. He emphasized that these rising costs were not unique to Oklahoma and had affected heavy highway construction nationwide. He reported that the Department is still working to align the published cost estimates in the 8-Year Plan with actual construction award figures.

The rebalance process, currently underway, will carry through the summer, with the updated 8-Year Construction Work Plan anticipated for completion by September or October 2025. He further stated that the impacts of inflation extended beyond construction to maintenance, equipment, and personnel expenses, requiring strategic prioritization of projects to extend the life cycle of recent improvements.

Gatz updated the Commission on an emergency project at the Roosevelt Causeway near Lake Texoma. A \$5.5 million emergency contract was awarded to Bridge Co. during the June 2025 Commission meeting, and the contractor commenced work the same evening. Major repairs, including causeway, guardrail, surface restoration, rumble strips, and striping, were completed by the end of June. New utility poles were installed the following week. Over 70,000 tons of material were used, and the project team succeeded in restoring two-lane traffic prior to the July 4th holiday, ensuring minimal disruption to lake access. Gatz commended Bridge Co. for their rapid performance and early completion, which earned them the project's incentive. He also acknowledged District two, led by Anthony Echelle, for managing the work effectively, and expressed gratitude to OG&E for their collaboration in restoring electrical operations disrupted by the emergency.

Gatz reported on progress made in Guymon on the US-54 corridor, a major international freight route. The \$33 million resurfacing project was designed by Smith Roberts Baldischwiler and constructed by Duit Construction. Senator Casey Murdock, Representative Kenton Patzkowsky, city officials, and local community members participated in the project's recent milestone event. Gatz praised the efforts of Resident Manager Tonya Folsom for maintaining open communication with local businesses and residents during the project. He noted that the pavement quality and overall execution were excellent and emphasized the Department's continued work in Guymon and the Panhandle area.

The Commission received updates on several upcoming construction projects. In District two, Latimer County, a \$7 million widening and resurfacing project on US-270 will add safety shoulders between Hartshorne and Wilburton.

District three, Lincoln County, a \$21 million project on US-177 would widen and resurface the roadway between SH-105 and the Payne County line, replacing a bridge over Headquarters Creek. The project is expected to last approximately 14 months, weather permitting.

District three, Pontotoc County, a \$3 million project on SH-1 near Ada will convert a divided four-lane into five lanes and improve pavement conditions over an estimated six-month timeline.

District eight, Creek County, an asphalt rehabilitation project valued at \$10 million is scheduled on SH-66 between Stroud and Depew. Gatz noted the importance of completing this project in time for the upcoming Route 66 Centennial Celebration.

Gatz provided an update on the Heartland Flyer, noting that the Texas legislature had not funded the Texas share of the train's operating costs. The annual operating cost was approximately \$10.5 million, with Oklahoma contributing \$4.5 million and ticket sales generating around \$2.5 million. The remaining balance was historically funded by Texas. He informed the Commission that the North Texas Council of Governments is considering whether they could provide temporary funding to support the service for another year. Without this support, service would be suspended at the end of September 2025. Gatz assured the Commission he would provide further updates at the August Commission meeting.

The safety message for the month focused on summer travel. Gatz urged the public to ensure trailers were properly secured, all passengers were buckled in, and distractions such as cell phones are avoided and reminded the traveling public to slow down in construction zones. Gatz also encouraged the continued use of the Drive Oklahoma app for route planning and up-to-date construction alerts.

Chairman Bob Peterson acknowledged the attendance of Representative Wilk and Senator Frix and expressed appreciation for their presence. He reflected on his seven years on the Commission and commended the professionalism, fiscal responsibility, and dedication of ODOT's staff. He gave special recognition to Chief Taylor for his 36 years of service.

SUBJECT: Change Order Exceeding Statutory Limits

LOCATION: District III, Cleveland County, SH-9 over US-77

a) On April 7, 2025, the Oklahoma Transportation Commission awarded a joint seal and repair contract to B&B Construction Service J.T., Inc. for \$537,175.71 with a timeframe of 140 calendar days.

On July 11, 2025, a Gradall machine owned by the City of Norman struck the eastbound SH-9 bridge (Bridge B) over US-77. Following the incident, the ODOT Bridge Division conducted an inspection and recommended that Beam 1 be re-sectioned, and Beam 2 be flame-straightened to restore structural integrity.

This contract includes planned work on Bridge B. However, the Bridge Division advised that no work should proceed on Bridge B until the necessary repairs to Beams 1 and 2 are completed. Delaying this repair work would impact the Contractor's schedule. To avoid unnecessary delays, the District recommends incorporating the additional repair work into the current contract with B&B Construction Service J.T., Inc., who is capable of performing the work. Incorporating the additional repair work into the existing contract will save ODOT time and money.

The department acknowledges the need for this change order and recommends approval for an additional \$300,000.00. Because this amount exceeds the statutorily authorized 15% limit on new contract items, Commission approval is required and requested.



b) This resurface contract was awarded by the Oklahoma Transportation Commission on February 6, 2023, to Becco Contractors, Inc. for a total contract amount of \$657,000.00. The contract time was 30 calendar days.

Upon completion of the project, a portion of the newly finished asphalt pavement began to exhibit movement between E. Cleveland Avenue and E. McKinley Avenue on US-75A in Sapulpa that resulted in a washboard effect on the new surface. This was not a result of the material quality, as it passed all testing protocols. Upon exploration by the ODOT Geotechnical team, it was discovered that a layer of brick, wood, and concrete was underlying the asphalt. After further discussions with City of Sapulpa officials, it was determined that the discovery represented remnants of old trolley tracks that ran through Sapulpa. To remedy the pavement surface defects the unstable brick and wood will need to be removed and repaved with asphalt. The anticipated cost of this work is \$140,000.00

Since the total cost causes the contract to exceed the statutory limit of 15% on new items, Commission approval is required. The necessity for this change order is recognized by the Department and approval is required.

Approval is recommended.

SUBJECT: Emergency Declaration, Bridge Impact Damage – Information Only

LOCATION: District VII, Comanche County

On Wednesday, July 2, 2025, ODOT was made aware of an over-height vehicle impact in District VII located at Deyo Mission Road over US-62 westbound, approximately 3.0 miles west of Lawton, Oklahoma in Comanche County. The vehicle impacting the bridge was traveling west with its bed up when it impacted the bridge. The responsible party is known.

Upon notification, ODOT Bridge Division and District VII promptly mobilized to the site to find that the bridge had received significant damage to a large portion of an exterior beam as well as damaged interior diaphragms and other structural elements which reduced the load capacity of the bridge. It was determined from the hands-on inspection and analysis that the bridge could remain open to one lane but would require additional inspection and repair to fully open the bridge.

For safety and economic reasons, it was imperative that two lanes of traffic be restored as soon as possible. The required work to repair this bridge is beyond the capability of the District VII and ODOT personnel. The required repairs included damaged portions of the structure to be flame-straightened and other portions to be repaired with new materials before normal traffic could be restored.

To perform the repairs, an Emergency Declaration was issued by the Executive Director on July 3, 2025 for a value of \$600,000.00. In accordance with 61 Okla. Stat. § 130, and the Oklahoma Administrative Code, section 730:1-5-1(4).

Following the Declaration, a contract was issued to Flame On, Inc. to perform the work. The work was completed and the bridge traffic was restored by July 17, 2025.

Information only, approval is not required.


SUBJECT: Damage to State Property

LOCATION: District II, Choctaw County

On July 9, 2024, a motorist driving a car northbound on US-70 Bypass/Indian Nation Turnpike, near the city of Hugo departed the roadway. The motorist struck an embankment, causing the vehicle to go airborne and strike the underside of the bridge of County Road E2070 (NBI 17269). The motorist suffered a fatal injury. The damage to the bridge is \$161,594.95. The damager had \$50,000.00 in liability insurance coverage and the damager's insurance has offered the entire \$50,000.00 policy limit as settlement to ODOT.

As the damager is deceased, and the damager's insurer has offered the full policy limit, the Office of General Counsel has determined that no further efforts of collections should be pursued.

Approval is recommend.
