SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING ON PRECONSTRUCTION AND HUMAN RESOURCES – Commissioners, Alexander, Dyson and Grimsley.

1. **Item No. 120 - Programming of Federal Railroad Crossing Safety Funds - Section 130 Title 23 Funds - Mr. Schwennesen**
 - a) **McCurtain County – Commission District II**

Texas, Oklahoma & Eastern rail lines: Construction funding for the installation of new Yield signs, reflective metal strips and fasteners at 27 locations in McCurtain County, ODOT Division 2. Total cost is \$4,772.38
 - b) **Multiple Counties – Commission District VIII**

South Kansas & Oklahoma rail lines: Construction funding for the installation of new Crossbuck Sign assemblies with Yield signs and break-away posts at 17 locations in Rogers, Tulsa and Washington Counties in ODOT Division VIII. Total cost is \$37,142.55
 - c) **Multiple Counties – Commission Districts III, IV, V, VII & VIII**

Stillwater Central, Hollis & Eastern rail lines: Construction funding for the installation of new Crossbuck Sign assemblies with Yield signs and break-away posts at 85 locations throughout, Lincoln County, ODOT Division III, Canadian, Oklahoma and Payne Counties, ODOT Division IV, Jackson County, ODOT Division V, Caddo, Comanche and Grady Counties, ODOT Division VII, as well as Pawnee, Creek and Tulsa Counties, ODOT Division VIII. The improvements on all of the routes operated by the Stillwater Central in Oklahoma. Total cost is \$176,553.30
 - d) **Leflore County – Commission District II**

Kansas City Southern rail line: additional funding for boring, rock, and a retaining wall necessary to facilitate the completion of a signal project which includes the installation of pedestal-mounted flashing light signals with gate arms, and two 56' concrete crossing surfaces at SH-128 in Leflore County, ODOT Division II. The funding originally authorized by the OTC was \$668,991 and the additional authorization being requested is \$109,262.65. Total project cost increases to \$778,253.65
