


Submitting an Interstate Application

(This would be used to change or update the name, phone number, DBA and/or email for the firm.)

1. Please log in to the CRCC system at <https://okdot.gob2g.com/?TN=okdot>
2. Once logged in you will select the “Renew/Apply” link located at the top right of the page under the **Key Actions** section.



3. You will see an option to select if you are a certified firm with ODOT; you will click on the link that says “seeking certification”.
