I am writing to express my support for the Oklahoma Department of Transportation's (ODOT) application for the Active Transportation Infrastructure Investment Program (ATIIP) Grant for the Bridging the Gap: Multimodal Connections on I-35 over the Oklahoma River project. If awarded, this project will add a new bridge over the Oklahoma River which will connect communities to downtown Oklahoma City.
