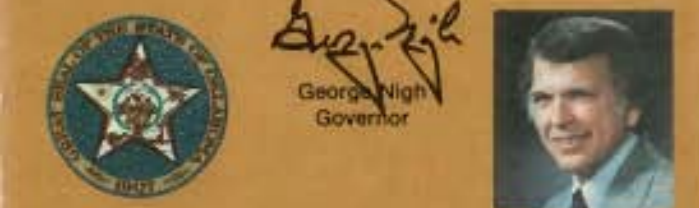




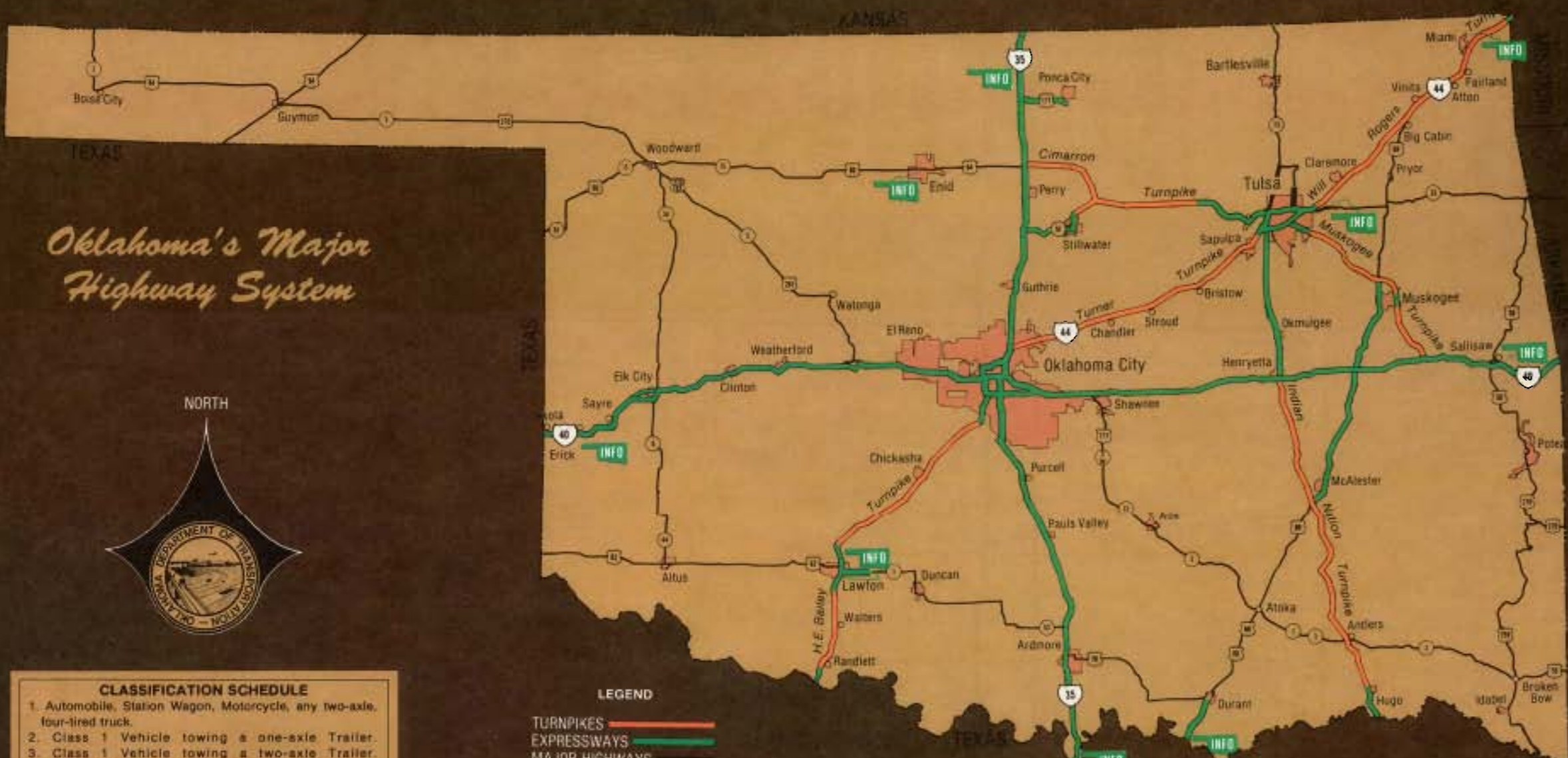

**CLASSIFICATION SCHEDULE**

1. Automobile, Station Wagon, Motorcycle, any two-axle, four-tired truck.
2. Class 1 Vehicle towing a one-axle Trailer.
3. Class 1 Vehicle towing a two-axle Trailer.
4. Two-axle Bus and two-axle, six-tired Truck.
5. Three-axle Truck, single or combination, and three-axle Bus.
6. Four-axle combination Truck.
7. Five-axle combination Truck.
8. Six-axle combination Truck.

**NOTE:** The Turner and Will Rogers Turnpikes are "Closed System" turnpikes. The driver is issued a ticket by the toll booth attendant as he enters the turnpike and pays the fare as he leaves the turnpike. The H.E. Bailey, Indian Nation, Muskogee and Cimarron Turnpikes are "Open System" turnpikes. The driver pays his fare each time he goes through a toll plaza.
