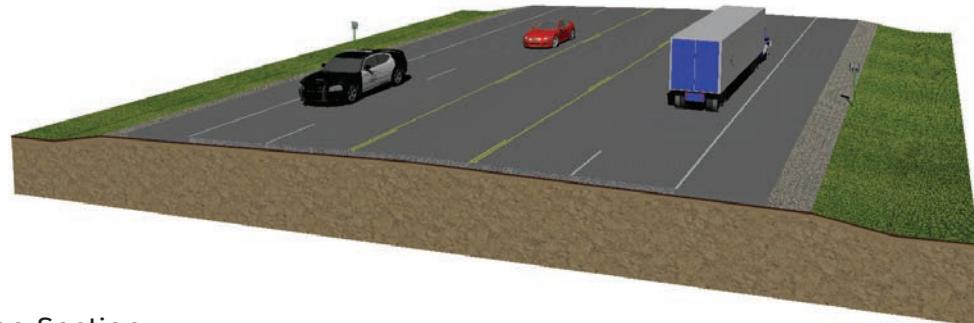
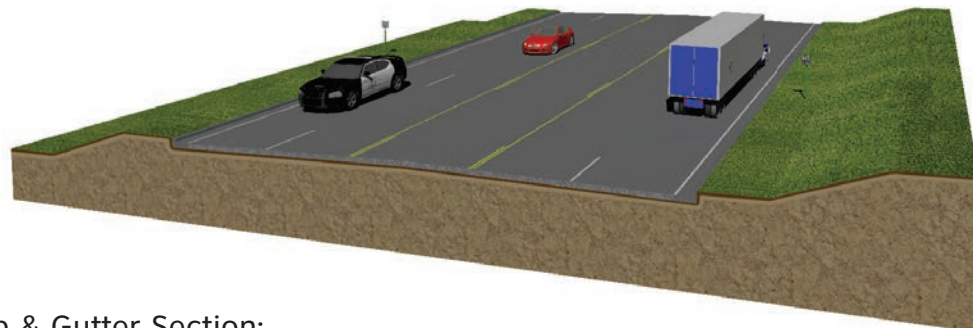


PROPOSED TYPICAL SECTIONS

- Two 10-Foot Shoulders

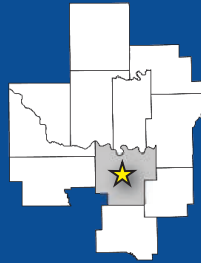


Curb & Gutter Section:

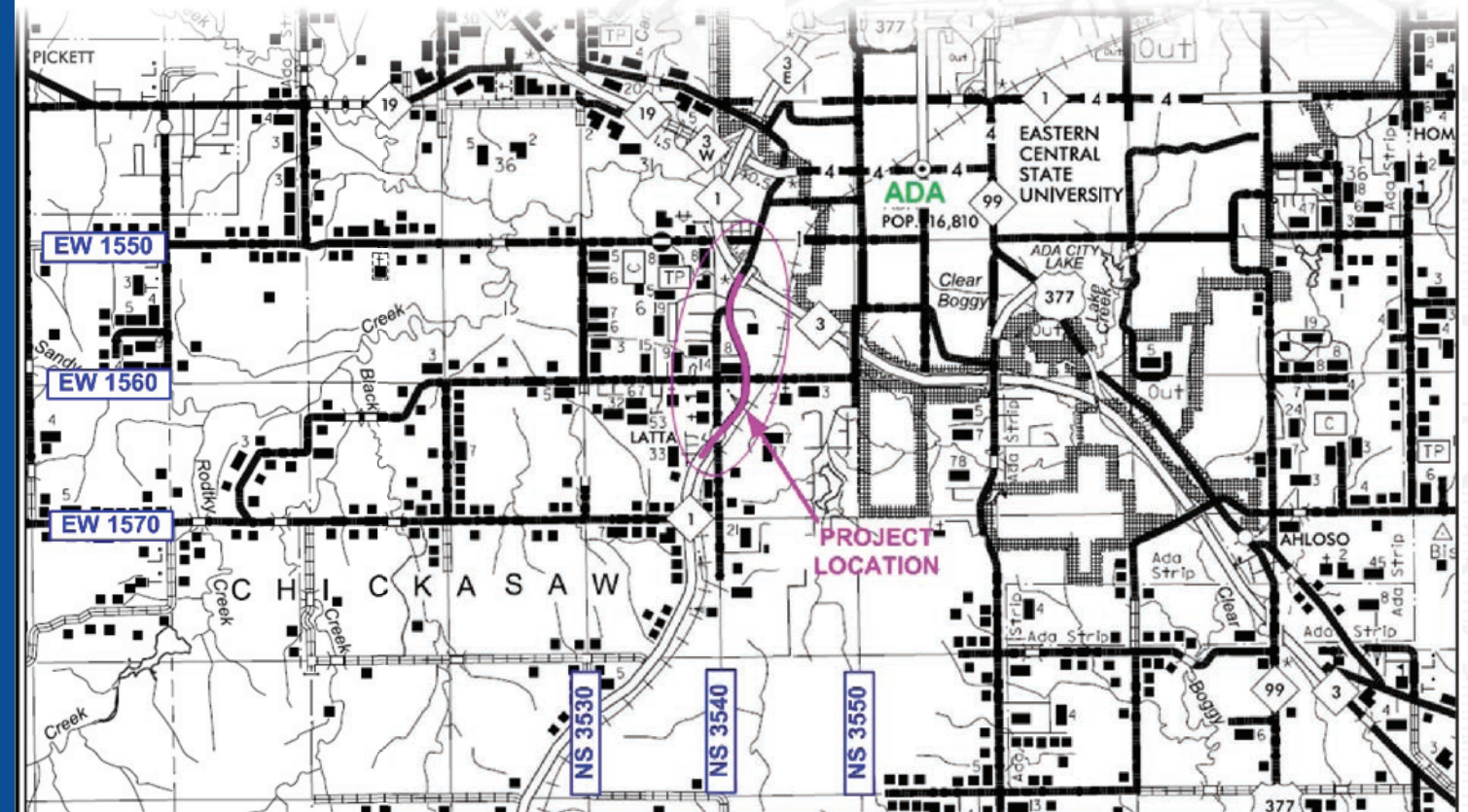
DESCRIPTION

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), proposes to widen State Highway SH-1 from two to four lanes starting from the existing 4 lane section 1.5 miles south of SH-3 and extending north to the SH-3 interchange. Existing SH-1 is a two lane highway with 10 feet wide shoulders. There are several intersections with high accidents within this extent. The current and projected traffic on the highway warrants four lanes.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Open House is to inform the public and solicit input for the proposed changes to SH-1.

The purpose of the project is to improve the capacity, connectivity and safety of the roadway.

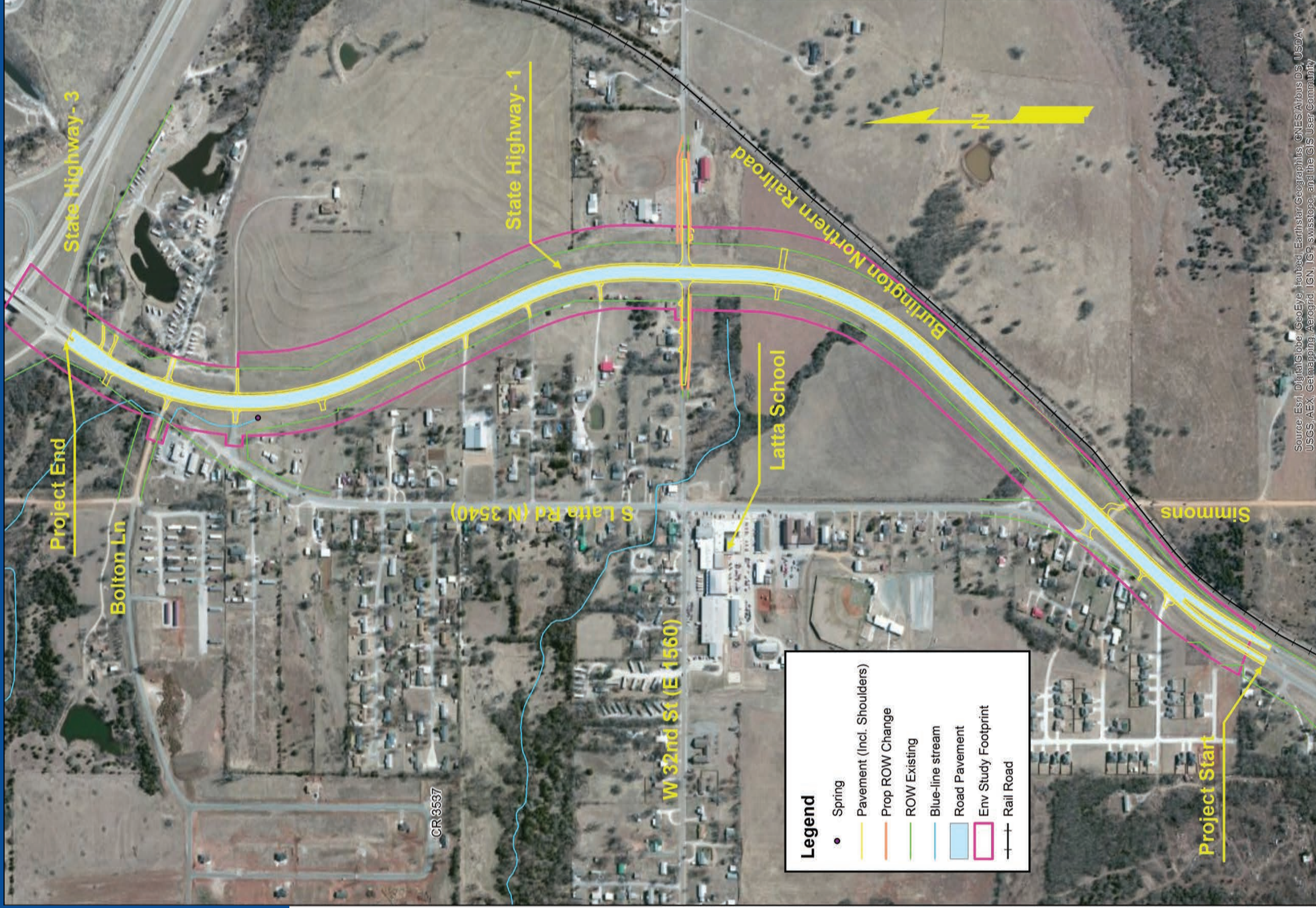
