



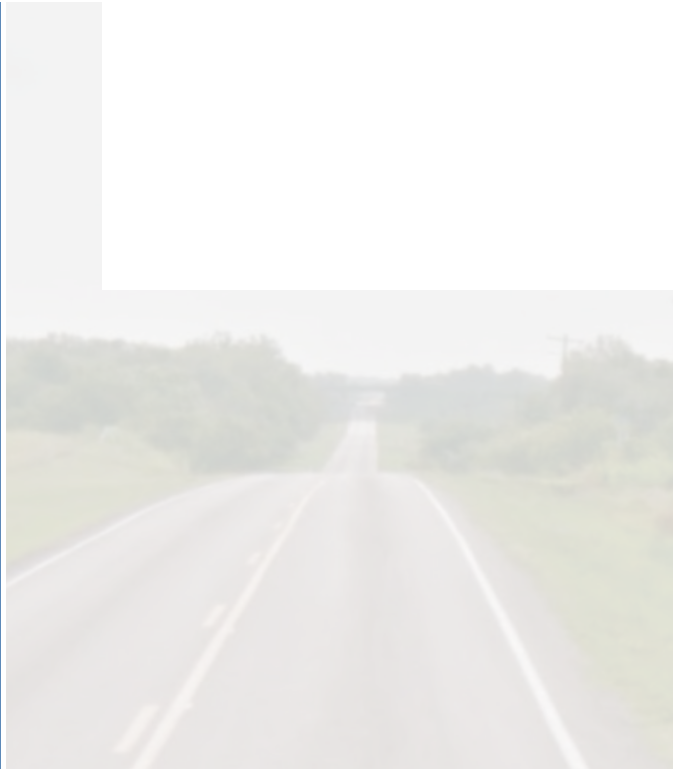

## **PUBLIC MEETING**



The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is proposing to improve State Highway 53 (SH-53) from just west of County Road NS-323 (Peach Tree Road) extending east approximately 5.57 miles through the I-35 interchange in Carter County.

A Public Meeting is being held to present the project information. The meeting will include a presentation about the proposed improvements to highway/bridge, including why the improvements are needed, the type of improvements proposed, and the expected impacts to motorists and the surrounding community. The purpose of the meeting is to obtain information from the public to further assist in the identification of critical social, economic and environmental effects that may result from the project.
