

SH-51 CONNECTION WITH MUSKOGEE TURNPIKE (SH-351) WAGONER COUNTY, OKLAHOMA JP33806(04)



TIMELINE TO CONSTRUCTION - The Oklahoma Department of Transportation 8-year construction plan has this project scheduled to begin construction in federal fiscal year 2026.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE - The project is estimated to take 400 calendar days.

PROPERTY ACCESS DURING CONSTRUCTION - Access to homes, businesses, and property adjacent to the project will be maintained during all phases of construction. In some cases, temporary drives may be required until permanent drives can be restored.

LOCAL DETOURS DURING CONSTRUCTION - The existing bridge over the Muskogee Turnpike will be removed and replaced just to the northwest the current location. Some of the construction can be completed before the bridge will need to be closed. During the time the road is closed, access across the Turnpike will be provided via Midway Road to the west and via S. 286th E. Ave to the east.

ROUNDABOUT NEED – Roundabouts were utilized in the design of this project to balance the need for safe and efficient traffic flow while providing access to the corridor for existing and future development.

NOISE IMPACT – There is an ongoing noise study that will compare this new project to ambient noise levels in the area. The results of this study will determine if noise mitigation measures will be warranted. The results of the noise study will be made available to the public.

SIGNALIZATION – There will be a traffic signal installed at intersection of SH-51 and the new connection to the Muskogee Turnpike, along with future signals at the ramp terminals to the new Turnpike Interchange.
