

Oklahoma 2025-2050 Long Range Transportation Plan

Vision and Goals



The 2025-2050 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) outlines the future of Oklahoma's transportation system. It sets a clear vision and seven strategic goals that will guide investment, policy, and planning decisions over the next 25 years. The goals directly address the needs and desires shared by the public and stakeholders during the engagement process.

The Vision

Oklahoma's transportation system must do more than move people and goods. It must support a strong economy, protect public safety, and adapt to challenges like aging infrastructure, population shifts, and changing technology.

To guide this work, ODOT established the following vision:

To provide a connected, multimodal transportation system that supports a thriving economy and improved quality of life for Oklahomans by providing for safe and efficient movement of people and goods.

This vision reflects a statewide commitment to accessibility, safety, and long-term reliability.

From Goals to Action

Each goal is supported by specific objectives that help guide how ODOT and its partners plan, prioritize, and deliver activities. These objectives address everything from reducing fatalities to improving multimodal access and making better use of funding tools. Objectives are measurable and aligned with performance measures, helping ensure accountability across the system. The full list of objectives are listed in Chapter 3 in the 2050 LRTP.

Together, the vision, goals, and objectives form the strategic foundation for ODOT's decision-making through 2050.

Mobility & Accessibility

Proactively engage local communities to ensure access for all users of the transportation system and increase travel options.



Economic Vitality

Provide an efficient and well-connected transportation system to support a healthy and competitive Oklahoma economy.



Operations & Management

Promote efficient, collaborative, and transparent operations to fund and deliver maximum system performance.



Environment & Quality of Life

Minimize and mitigate transportation-related impacts to natural environments, cultural resources, and public health.



Resiliency & Reliability

Ensure the reliability of movement for people and goods by enhancing the resiliency and adaptability of the transportation system.
