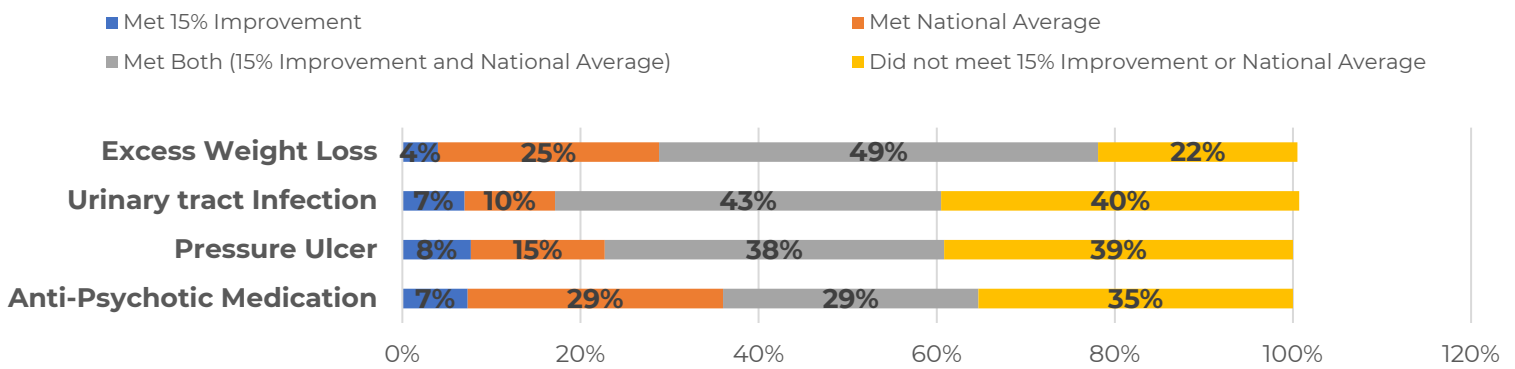
The Pay for Performance program, centers around 4 CMS long stay measures with predetermined benchmarks.

- N031.03 Percentage of long stay residents who received an anti-psychotic medication.
- N015.03 Percentage of long stay residents with high risk/unstageable pressure ulcers.
- N024.02 Percentage of long stay residents with urinary tract infection.
- N029.02 Percentage of long stay residents who lose to much weight.

The program allows facilities to center on member care, the ability to achieve above and beyond the standard level of care and personalize their relationships with those they serve. OHCA works in collaboration with our Oklahoma state agencies, community partners and stakeholder organizations to ensure program standards and practices are effective in fostering ongoing quality.

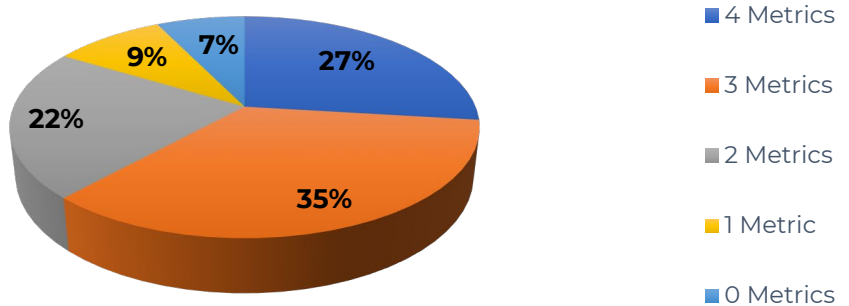

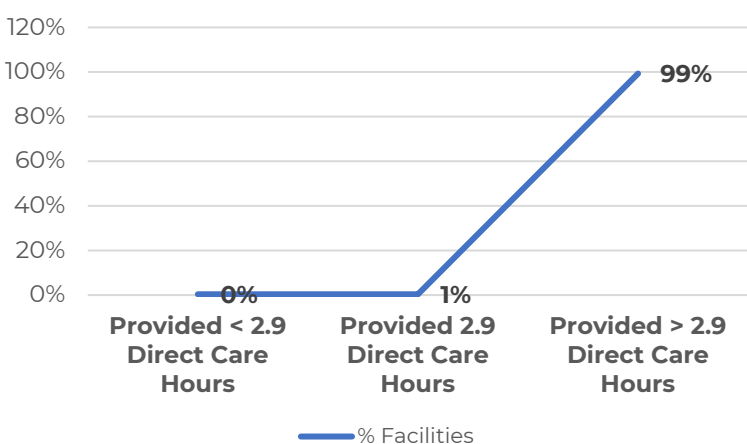

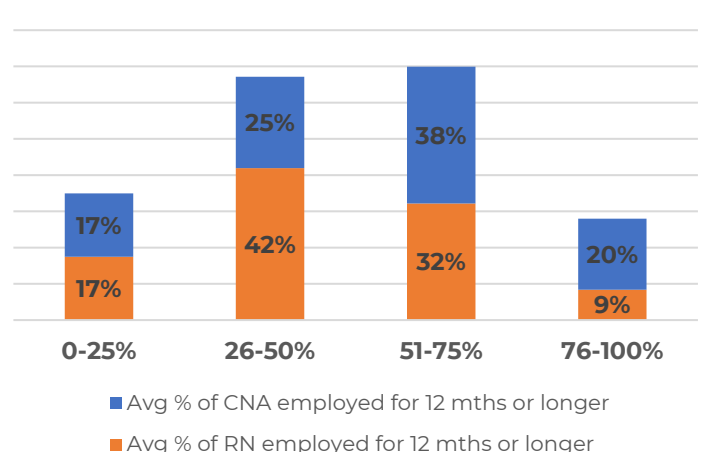
Metrics Met by Facilities Apr.-Jun. 2023
