Tribal Consultation

BMTC, TCAM & TPPS



Background

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) strives to work with sovereign tribal governments on a government-to-government basis to address pertinent issues, and OHCA shall provide an opportunity for tribal governments to participate in policy development to the greatest extent practicable and permitted by law.

Bi-Monthly Tribal Consultation (BMTC)

OHCA convenes bi-monthly tribal consultation meetings on the first Tuesday of every odd month. These scheduled meetings allow for input from our tribal partners on all policy and to provide an opportunity to seek information from OHCA on all proposed policy and implementation.

Tribal Consultation Annual Meeting (TCAM)

OHCA convenes a tribal consultation annual meeting, which includes sovereign tribal government officials and designees, Indian Health Services, tribal organizations, Urban Indian Health Clinics and OHCA. The meeting, in which OHCA reviews the fiscal year annual report for tribal governments, consists of an open forum for all attendees to participate in and discuss tribal priorities, recommendations and initiatives to be considered at the upcoming Tribal Partnership Planning Session where goal-setting begins.

Tribal Partnership Planning Sessions (TPPS)

OHCA and tribal governments work on creating an effective action plan that will guide activities and objectives for the next two years. Top issues presented by tribal partners at TCAM will be discussed. The outcome is to determine achievable goals and objectives to help create a solid partnership.
