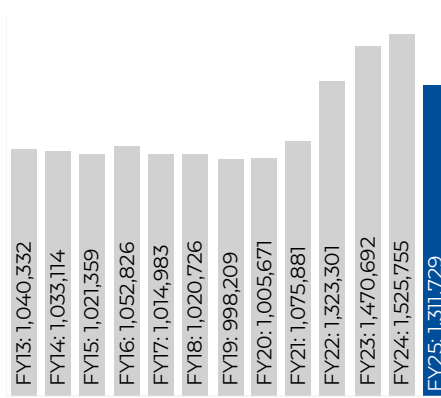

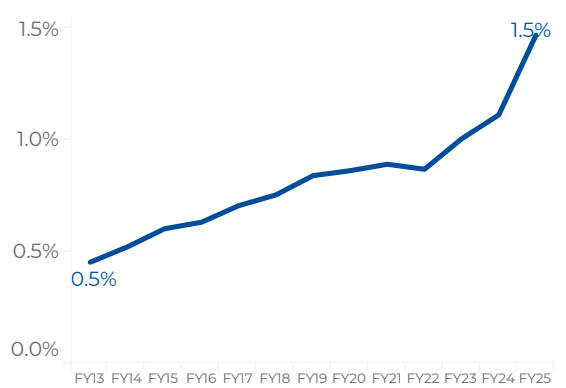
The number and prevalence of members diagnosed with ASD continued to increase between SFY24 and SFY25, from 16,942 (1.1%) in SFY25 to 19,233 (1.5%) in SFY2025.

The rate of growth increased substantially. What looked like linear growth before SFY22 accelerated between SFY24 and SFY25.

SFY2013 - SFY2025

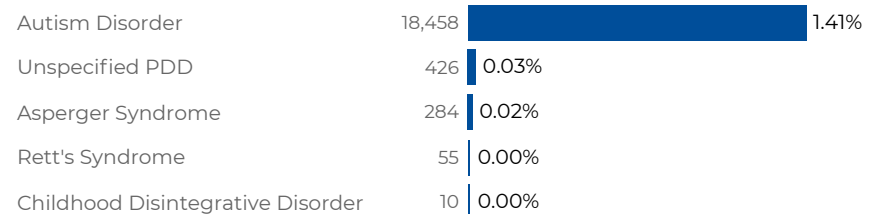

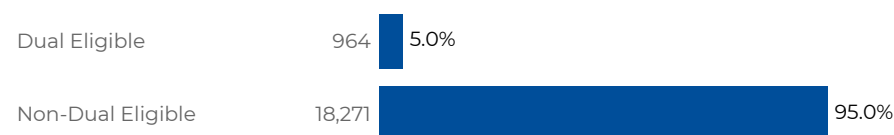

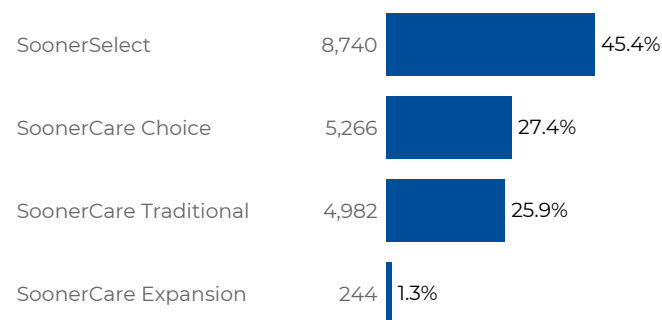

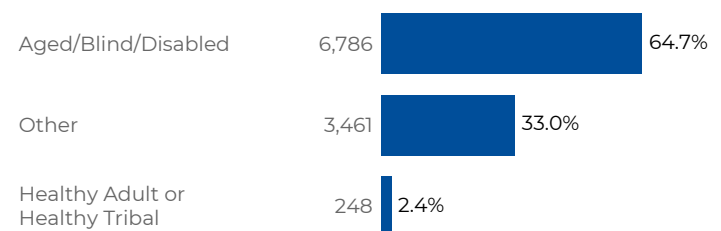

Qualifying Group SFY2025 (<10 excluded)



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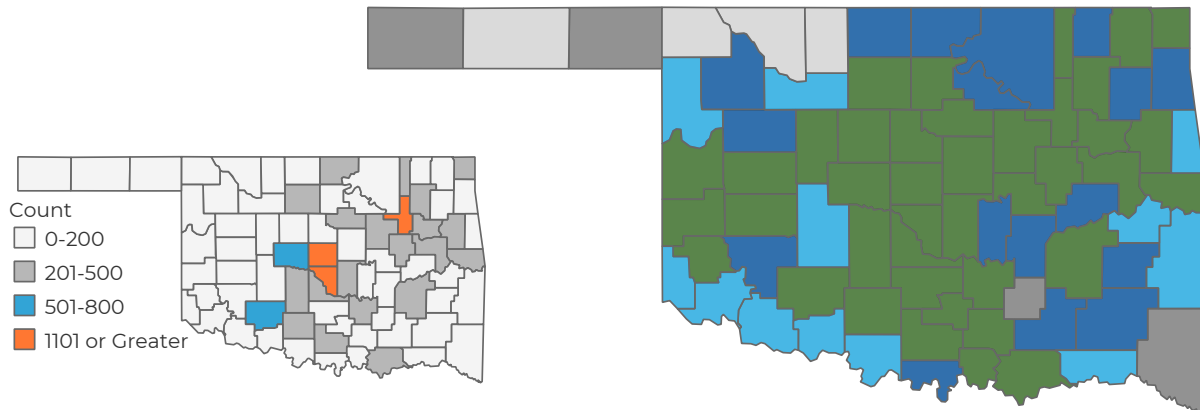

Prevalence Rates



Just 9 counties had prevalence rates of 1.2% or greater in SFY23, rising to 24 counties in SFY24. The diagnosis is essentially ubiquitous now, except for the westernmost counties.

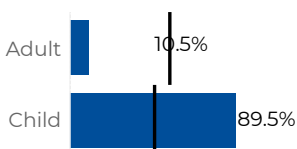


SoonerCare Members with Autism Spectrum Disorder

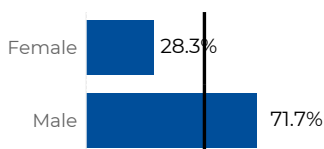

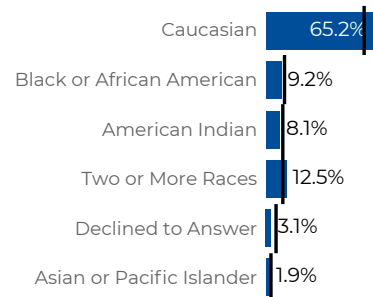

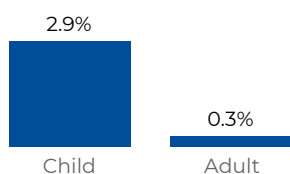

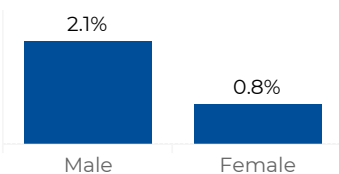

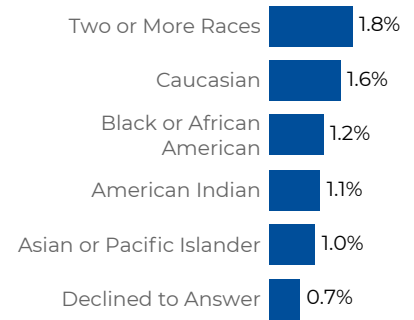

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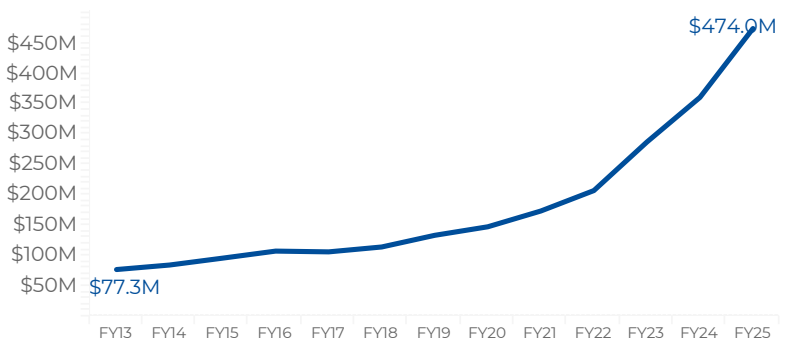

Reimbursement Cost

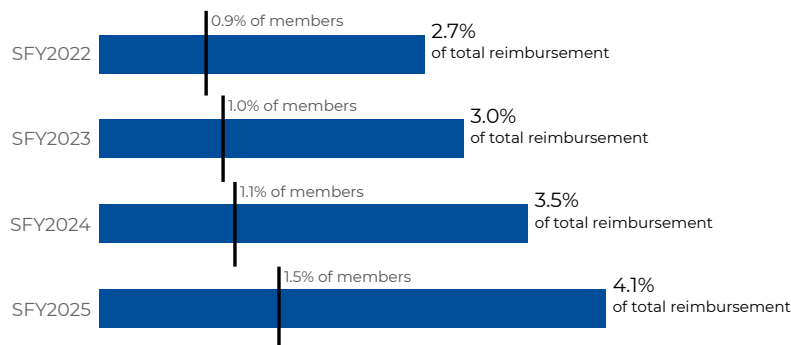
Members with ASD comprised 1.5% of all SoonerCare members in SFY24. However, the total reimbursement associated with services rendered for members with ASD made up 4.1% of all reimbursements paid in SFY24. The total reimbursement for members with ASD increased from \$360M in SFY23 to \$470M in SFY2024.

Total annual reimbursements and per-member reimbursements for members with ASD are increasing faster than linearly in recent years.

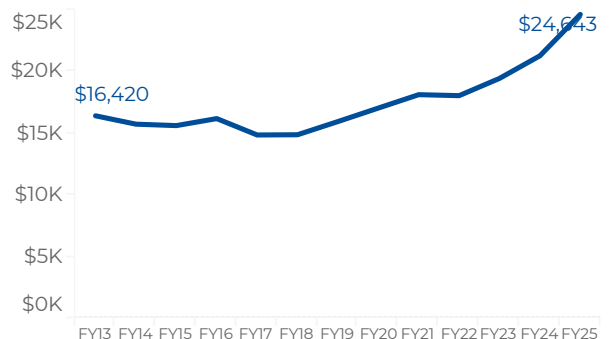
Annual Reimbursement for Members with Autism Spectrum Disorder
