
#### SCHIP Breakdown of Total Enrollment





#### **SoonerCare Sees Jump in Use of Dental Benefits**

OKLAHOMA CITY – Over the past five years, SoonerCare (Oklahoma Medicaid) has seen an increase of almost 250 percent in the number of members receiving dental services through the program.

In 2003, almost 68,000 members had received dental services, but that number jumped to almost 236,000 in 2008.

The number of enrolled dental providers also sharply increased, from 461 in 2003 to 1,046 in 2008, a jump of almost 127 percent.

Dr. Leon Bragg, SoonerCare dental director, attributes the rise in use of dental benefits to a number of factors: the larger network of dentists, an increased fee schedule and the convenience of electronic billing. Members also are reminded of the importance of regular dental care for children and pregnant women in their contacts with OHCA's child health and prenatal care staff.

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, more U.S. children are affected by tooth decay than any other chronic infectious disease. If untreated, tooth decay causes pain and infections that may lead to problems with eating, speaking, playing and learning.

Children who see a dentist regularly also have increased opportunities to learn good oral health habits that will benefit them for a lifetime.

According to the American Dental Association, proper oral hygiene may decrease the risk of maternal gum disease, pre-term birth and low birth weights in babies. OHCA's Perinatal Dental Access Program offers dental benefits from exams and cleanings to fillings and gum treatments.
