There are several updates to the pharmacy program. Please review the following items and share with your pharmacy staff. The Pharmacy Help Desk will be closed Sunday, July 4th and Monday, July 5th for the Independence Day Holiday.

## **Prior Authorization and Step Therapy Changes**

OHCA started a Medicaid Supplemental State Rebate Program earlier in the year. Beginning July 1, 2004, several drugs will become available without prior authorization. The current rebate contract runs through December 31, 2004. These companies may agree to extend their rebates at that time. As of July 1, 2004, PA's will no longer be required for the following drugs:

Mobic

Nexium

Prevacid
