317:45-11-40. Contracted insurance agent eligibility and reimbursement for enrollment services

(a) In order for an insurance agent to be reimbursed for enrollment services, the agent must:

- (1) have a contract with the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) to provide enrollment services;
- (2) have an active license with the Oklahoma Insurance Department; and
- (3) meet all contracting, education and training requirements set forth by OHCA.

(b) Reimbursement for enrollment services is:

- (1) restricted to the Individual Plan (IP) program;
- (2) made only to eligible and contracted insurance agents;
- (3) limited to one enrollment fee per household per 12 months;
- (4) dependent upon the completion and certification of IP applications that result in actual member enrollment;
- (5) established by rates that are determined and set by OHCA; and
- (6) subject to periodic review and audit by OHCA.

317:45-11-41. Audits

Agents are subject to audits related to payments collected for enrollment services. Eligibility may be revoked at any time if fraudulent activity is suspected. Any monies paid in error are subject to recoupment.
