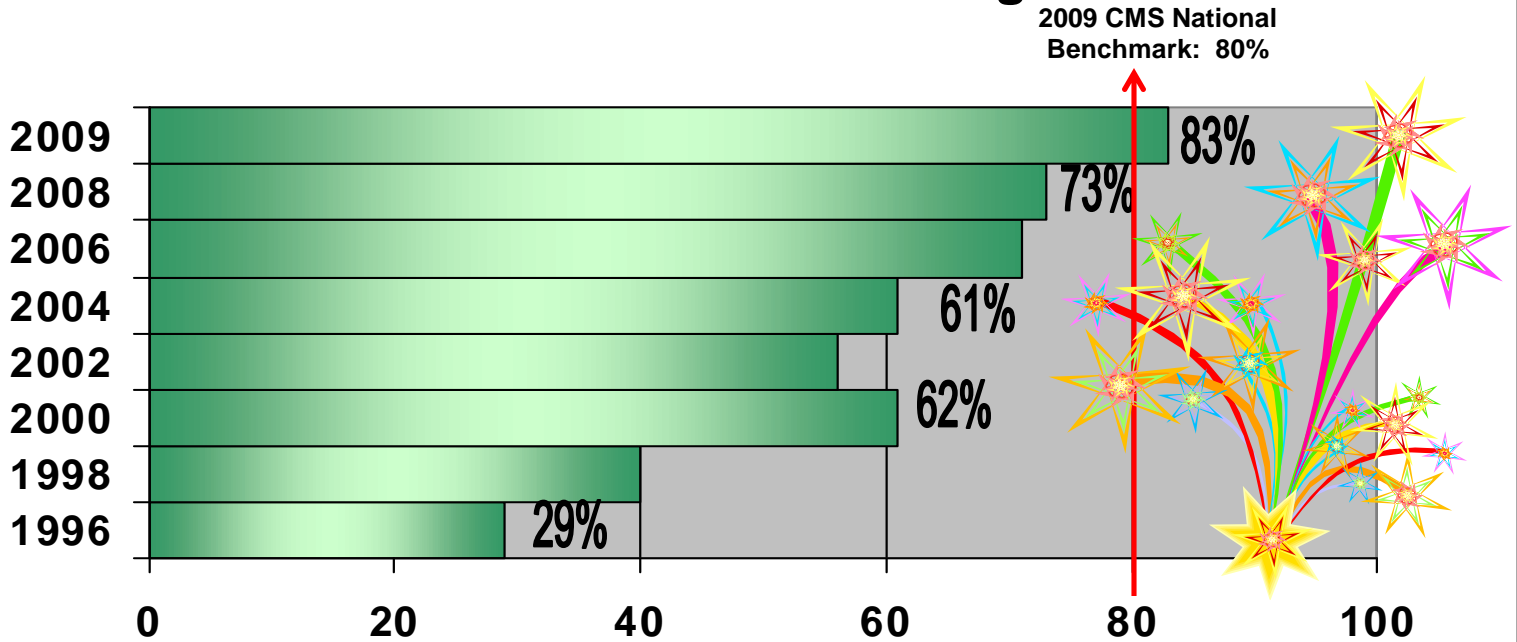

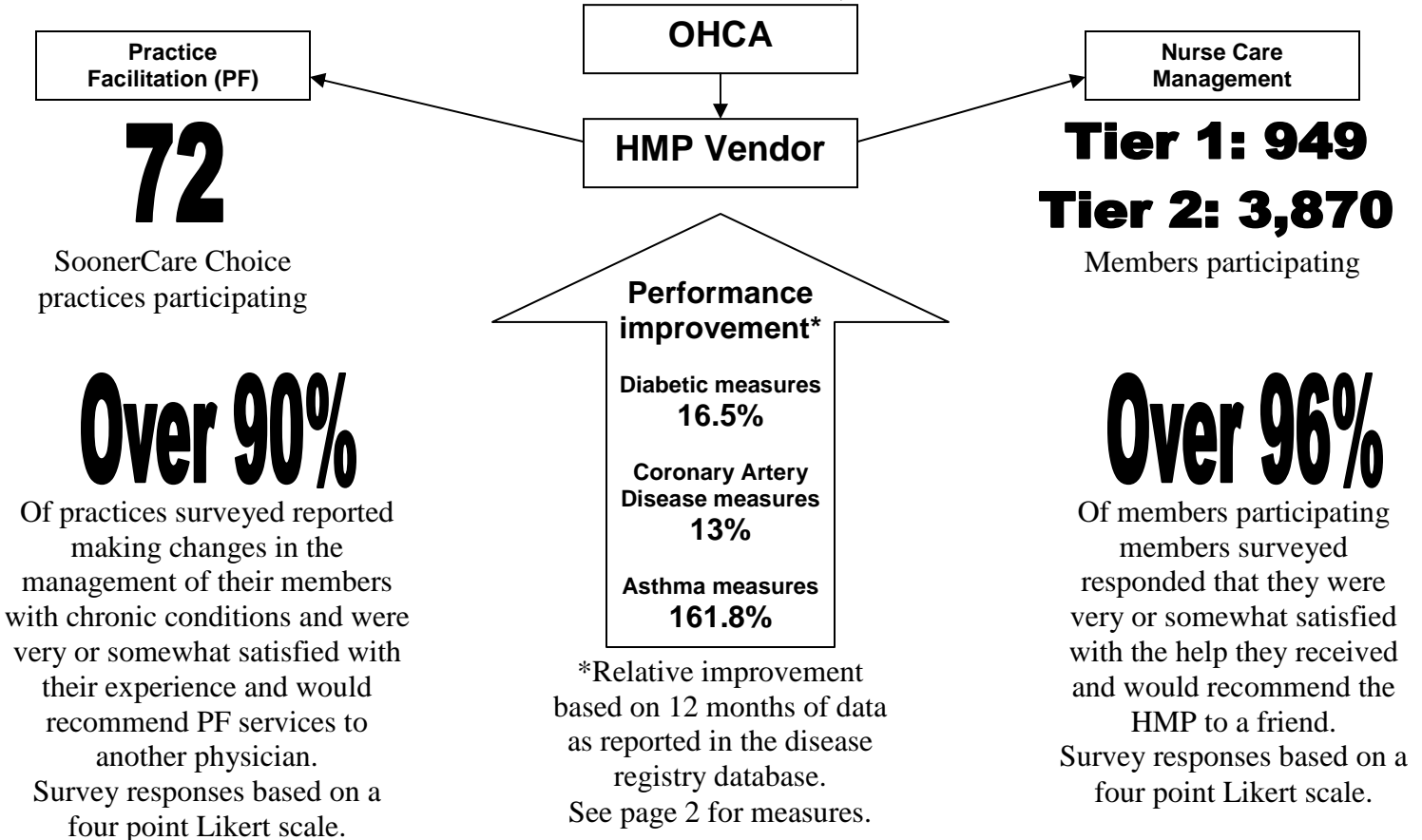
SoonerCare Well Child Checkup (EPSDT Screening) Rates Reach All-Time High!



Health Management Program (HMP) Update


Implemented February 2008 as a result of Medicaid Reform Act of 2006

<p>Coronary Artery Disease</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Antiplatelet therapy • Drug therapy for lowering LDL cholesterol • Beta-Blocker therapy-prior myocardial infarction (MI) • Blood pressure <140/90 • Lipid profile performed • Optimally managed modifiable risk • ACE/ARB inhibitor therapy • Symptom and activity assessment • Lipid profile performed & LDL < 100 	<p>Diabetes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HbA1c management • HbA1c management control (HbA1c < 9) • Blood pressure management • Lipid measurement • LDL cholesterol level <130 • LDL result <100 • Urine protein testing • Dilated eye exam • Foot Exam 	 <p>Asthma</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Asthma assessment • Pharmacologic therapy

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<p>SoonerCare Prenatal Tobacco Cessation Initiative</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Grant initiative from the Tobacco Settlement Endowment Trust (TSET) ○ Partnership with OHCA Child Health Unit ○ Provide practice facilitation to OB/GYN practices with a high volume of SoonerCare Choice members to implement quality improvement projects <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase tobacco cessation activities • Increase use and billing of 5 A's
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Product Based Prior Authorization for Atypical Antipsychotics

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Implemented on April 1, 2010 • Result of coordinated efforts of OHCA pharmacy unit and the Drug Utilization and Review Board (DUR) • Members on tier 2 and 3 medications prior to April 1, 2010 will be grandfathered in and allowed to stay on current medications • Extensive outreach and education provided to stakeholders: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ APS Healthcare ○ Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (DMHSAS) ○ Department of Human Services (DHS) ○ OHCA Behavioral Health Advisory Council ○ OHCA Inpatient Quarterly Provider Meeting (Behavioral Health providers) ○ OHCA Child Health Task Force ○ Provider Services made calls to the top 100 prescribers of the atypical antipsychotics ○ Fax blast to pharmacies and SoonerCare PCPs ○ 2,000 letters sent to prescribers containing magnets to reinforce the tier one medication ○ Article planned for the member and provider newsletter
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
