- Tier one products are available without a prior authorization for all members above 18 years of age.
- Members 18 years or younger will be required to submit a prior authorization for consideration.
- All products have a quantity limit of #30 per 30 days.

Approval Criteria for Tier 2 Products:

- 1. Minimum of 30 day trial with at least two Tier 1 products and clinical documentation of attempts to correct any primary cause for insomnia.
- 2. FDA approved diagnosis.
- 3. No concurrent anxiolytic benzodiazepine therapy greater than TID dosing and no concurrent ADHD medications.
- 4. Approvals granted for 6 months.


Approval Criteria for Tier 3 Products:

- 1. Minimum of 30 day trial with at least two Tier 2 products and clinical documentation of attempts to correct any primary cause for insomnia.
- 2. FDA approved diagnosis.
- 3. No concurrent anxiolytic benzodiazepine therapy greater than TID dosing and no concurrent ADHD medications.
- 4. Approvals granted for 6 months.


