#### How much will we need and when?

- January 1, 2014 with 100% participation there will be approximately 200,000 new members and 50,000 woodwork members
  - State share cost of \$42 million
- With 57% participation there will be approximately 140,000 new members and 30,000 woodwork members
  - State share cost of \$24 million



## Planning Phase

- Budget Request for Fiscal Year 2013 is dueOctober 1, 2011
- What resources are needed?
  - FTE: Where are they needed, how many, and when should they be brought on board
  - Increase in contract services
  - Additional state dollars



#### Operational Phase

- Budget request for Fiscal Year 2014 due October1, 2012
- FTE needed to begin enrollment for new population on October 1, 2013
- Additional FTE for operations
- Contracted services increase and other professional service contracts increase
- Additional state dollars




### Additional Funding Changes

- InsureOK members, depending on their income, will either be eligible for SoonerCare at 100% federal participation or will become eligible for the exchange at zero state dollars.
- Breast and Cervical Cancer members, depending on their income, will either be eligible for SoonerCare at 100% federal participation or will become eligible for the exchange at zero state dollars.
