## Workday@ok Parallel Payroll Testing Resource Priority

Hello Agency Leaders:

As you know, we are well into the testing phase of the BrightPath project. We are working through Cycle 1 of Parallel Payroll Testing (PPT) and making good progress. However, there is still a tremendous amount of work to do to ensure your agency's payroll is correct when we transition to workday@ok.

We will move PPT testing to the ODOT Training Facility starting Monday, April 18. We are requesting that ALL agency payroll testers attend in person. If your agency is currently ahead on PPT tasks, we need your payroll teams to assist agencies that are behind. The facility opens at 7:30 a.m. each morning. The more we work together, the more we can accomplish and gathering in-person provides a wealth of knowledge and experience at everyone's fingertips.

Once again, we must stress that participation in PPT is **NOT optional**. All agencies who process their own payroll must review their payroll outputs to ensure correct, compliant payroll runs in workday@ok. As agency leaders, it is imperative that you ensure your payroll teams are actively involved in PPT and are making it a top priority.
