REVENUE VS. EXPENDITURES (IN MILLIONS)




- EXPENDITURE PROJECTIONS USE 13-YR NORMALIZED GROWTH RATE FROM ACTUAL (1.75%)




TREND-BASED PROJECTIONS (IN MILLIONS)


