INTRODUCTION

As prescribed in the State Use statute (74 O.S. § 3004), this procurement schedule contains all products and services available from qualified organizations in the State Use Program.

TABLE OF CONTENTS

QUALIFIED NONPROFIT AGENCIES

To be a qualified organization for the State Use Program, a nonprofit agency must meet two specific criteria:

- The agency must have been approved by the Wage and Hour Division of the U.S. Department of Labor as a sheltered workshop.
- The organization must have received certification to the State Use Program.

This definition is based on the administrative rule, OAC 260:120-1-3 – State Use Program Qualifications.

What is a sheltered workshop?

- A sheltered workshop is a nonprofit organization that provides employment and job skills training to individuals with disabilities. These workshops are a vital part of helping people with disabilities gain work experience and achieve greater independence.

Why is this important?

- The State Use Program is designed to support these organizations by giving them the opportunity to provide products and services to state agencies. By doing so, the program helps create and maintain employment for people with disabilities, which is a key goal of the State Use Program.

MANDATORY

The State Use Program designates certain products and services as mandatory. This means that state agencies are required to purchase these items from qualified organizations participating in the program. These items are defined by the following criteria:

- They have an established fair market value, which has been set and approved by the state purchasing director.
- Each item is assigned to a specific State Use statewide contract.
