2. Purpose of the Employer Manual

The Employer Manual is the primary resource to assist employers with their TRS functions including monthly and yearly reports.

3. About TRS

The Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma is a defined-benefit pension plan serving Oklahoma Educators and those whose primary work is associated with providing public education services in Oklahoma.

The Defined Benefit Plan is qualified under Section 401(a) of the Internal Revenue Code. Eligible retirees of the System's 401(a) plan receive a monthly benefit from their retirement date throughout their remaining lifetime through a formula based on years of service and final average salary of the member. The formula gives retirees a percentage of their

salary as a retirement benefit. The more years of service the member has at retirement, the greater the percentage of salary the member will receive at retirement.
