100% DISABLED VETERAN DECLARATION

Important Notice Regarding this Declaration

Purchases made by, or on behalf of, 100% disabled veterans/surviving spouses who qualify for the DAV sales tax exemption are limited to \$25,000.00 per calendar year for the veteran and \$1,000.00 per calendar year for the surviving spouse.

It is the responsibility of the qualifying veteran/surviving spouse to consider their actual and anticipated usage of the sales tax allowance for the current calendar year and declare the appropriate amount of remaining credit they wish to have applied to the purchase price of the vehicle referenced on the front of this Certificate for the purpose of exempting that amount from the assessment of sales tax.

By signing below, the affiant affirms the combined amount of their purchases already made and planned to be made exempt from sales tax in the current calendar year, along with the declared motor vehicle purchase price portion listed below, do not exceed the annual \$25,000 (veteran) or \$1,000 (surviving spouse) exemption limitation. Affiant further affirms that, should the applicable annual limitation be subsequently met this year, they will not claim exemption for future purchases of tangible personal property or services for the remainder of the calendar year.
